

# The Major's Kale

(a duet based on the C major scale)

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Moderate swing feel

## New concept: The Major scale (part 2)

The student part of this duet is based on the C major scale. It is meant to introduce you to the sound of the scale as well as to help you review the notes you learned in Book 1.

Note: it would be also be beneficial to practice the first two lines of this piece in the second and third positions, once you have learned the fingerings on page 6. If you really want to challenge yourself, you can try the teacher part to this duet.

### Technique:

You can play all the scale exercises in this book several different ways:

1. Use thumb on strings 4, 5 and 6; alternate i and m on strings 1, 2 and 3.
2. Alternate i and m for everything, free stroke or rest stroke.
3. Alternate p and i or m, free stroke (lute players use this technique).
